



### **Supplier Diversity**

At the Port Authority of NY & NJ, we believe our operations should include as wide a range of vendors and contractors – chosen for their skill and ability to work with us – as possible and we make extra efforts to locate and qualify those firms. As such, our supplier diversity program helps MWBEs, SDVOBs, and LBEs participate in Port Authority's business opportunities

The participation goals are as follows:

- 20% Minority Business Enterprises (MBE)
- 10% Women-owned Business Enterprises (WBE)
- 3% Service-Disabled Veteran-owned Businesses (SDVOB)
- 10% Local Business Enterprises (LBE)

We encourage each of our partners to make a good faith effort to achieve these goals








## Good Faith Efforts

Develop a 'Roadmap' to inform a comprehensive participation plan for evaluation and approval with goals applied for 20% MBE, 10% WBE, 3% SDVOB, and 10% LBE utilization

Create participation plans that provide meaningful opportunities for MBE/WBE/SDVOBs across the full spectrum of the project



Strongly encourage LBE participation for this opportunity

Develop contracting packages that are commensurate with capacity of the preponderance of the available pool of MBE/WBE/SDVOB/LBEs








## Good Faith Efforts

Encourage efforts to provide outreach to new diverse and developing businesses in all meaningful areas of work to offer opportunities to all qualified firms

Establish transparent processes for pre-qualifying and selecting firms

Assist in providing capacity building, technical guidance and trainings, and other needed business support services


Conduct business affairs with MBE/WBE/SDVOB/LBE partners in accordance with PANYNJ's standards, including within our supplier code of ethics, prompt payment protocols, etc.

## **LBE Participation**

We require good faith efforts to achieve 10% LBE goal across all phases, categories and tiers prioritized as follows:

**First Priority** ("Zone 1")

municipalities of Newark and Elizabeth

#### **Priority Zone 1A** ("Zone 1A")

All municipalities within a 5-mile radius of the outside border of the Airport

#### **Second Priority** ("Zone 2")

All firms within Essex, Union, and Hudson County outside of Newark and Elizabeth
